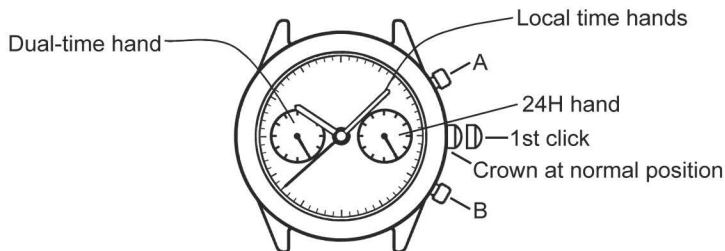


VD32 DUAL-TIME USER MANUAL



FUNCTIONS

Your VD32 watch will display your local time with the regular watch hands, and you can set it to display a secondary time zone using a subdial. It will also indicate your local AM/PM time in a subdial.

SETTING LOCAL TIME

1. When the second hand is at the 12:00 position, pull the crown to the first click and rotate it to set the time. The 24H hand indicates local time on an AM/PM scale (24 to 12 is AM, 12 to 24 is PM). Make sure the 24H hand is showing the correct hour (it will move with the hour and minute hands as you rotate the crown).

2. Press the crown back in firmly when your time setting is correct.

SETTING A SECONDARY TIME ZONE

1. To ensure accuracy of the setting, wait until the time in the secondary zone is at the top of an even-numbered hour (eg, 12:00, 2:00, 4:00, etc).
2. Pull the crown out to the first click.
3. Press and hold button A to move the dual-time hand back or button B to move the dual-time hand forward.
4. When the dual-time hand indicates the correct hour in the secondary time zone, press the crown back in firmly.

CHANGING THE SECONDARY TIME ZONE

1. Once you have set the secondary time zone, you can adjust it by pressing buttons A or B when the crown is pressed in.
2. Pressing button A will move the dual-time hand back one hour, and pressing button B will move it forward one hour.
